About Green Dragons (Taken from the Practical Guide to Dragons):

Maximum Height: 10 feet

Maximum Weight: 160,000 pounds

Maximum Wingspan: 80 Feet

Breath Weapon: Chlorine (Poison) gas

Favorite Foods: Little folks, such as gnomes/kender (elves)/children

Habitat: Forests with tall trees/Behind waterfalls

Enemy: Often fights for territory with Black Dragons

Favorite Treasure: Mementos of particularly exciting victories

Green Dragons love to fight. They have a long, slender forked tongue, like a snake. In fact, from above, Green Dragons appear to look like snakes, albeit giants green snakes with wings. They are very territorial. They will attack you for no reason. They also love to double cross unsuspecting victims.

Plot summary:

When ten-year-old Scamp Weaver finds a locked chest in a forest clearing, he feels like his life is finally about to change for the better.
