

**Official Rules**  
**Green Dragon Song Contest**

---

By entering the Wizards of the Coast LLC (“Wizards”) *Green Dragon Song Contest* (the “Contest”) you agree to be bound by these Official Rules.

**1. Eligibility: No purchase necessary.** VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. The Contest is open to legal residents of the United States ages eight (8) to fourteen (14), and to libraries located in the U.S. and Canada that have completed and submitted a Library Participation Form found at [www.mirrorstonebooks.com](http://www.mirrorstonebooks.com). Entrants may enter as an individual or in teams, but only one entry per individual or team, and a person may enter the Contest no more than once either as a member of a team, or once as an individual. Each team may have no more than four (4) members. The Contest begins at 12:01 a.m. PST on June 26, 2009 and ends at 12:00 a.m. (midnight) PST on August 9, 2009. **YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO MAKE A PURCHASE OR PROVIDE OTHER CONSIDERATION TO ENTER OR WIN.**

**2. How to enter:** For a library to participate in the Contest, it must return the completed Library Participation Form to Raab Associates at [info@raabassociates.com](mailto:info@raabassociates.com), or fax it to 914-241-0050. Individual and/or team entrants will fill out the applicable official entry form (as an individual or team member), located at [www.mirrorstonebooks.com](http://www.mirrorstonebooks.com). The entry form must be filled out completely by each entrant, and must be signed by a parent or guardian of each entrant. Entrants will submit their completed entry form and song lyrics entry to Raab Associates at [info@raabassociates.com](mailto:info@raabassociates.com), or fax it to 914-241-0050. **All completed entries, including lyrics and entry forms must be received by Raab Associates by 12:00 a.m. (midnight) PST no later than August 9, 2009.** Entries will not be acknowledged or returned. Wizards reserves the right to modify this, and any other, submission requirement in its sole discretion. Entries are the property of Wizards and will not be acknowledged or returned.

**3. Writing Your Entry:** Entrants should listen to the Dragon Song lyrics posted on the Wizards website [www.mirrorstonebooks.com](http://www.mirrorstonebooks.com) about the Red, Bronze, Black and Brass Dragons, and then write song lyrics (text only - no music) about the Green Dragon using information provided about the Green Dragon from the books; *The Practical Guide to Dragons* and *The Green Dragon Codex*. An information sheet with tips on writing lyrics and a sheet containing relevant information on the Green Dragon are provided at [www.mirrorstonebooks.com](http://www.mirrorstonebooks.com).

**4. Judging:** A committee comprised of selected Wizards employees will serve as judges of the Contest. The judges will review all eligible entries and will select one winner (winner may be a team or an individual entrant) based on the following criteria: adherence to the Dragon Song format (25%), originality (50%), and how well the lyrics fits the music provided (25%). The winner will be determined by Wizards on or about September 1, 2009. The winner and the corresponding participating library will be notified by e-mail or telephone. If the winner (or at least one team member) cannot be contacted at the contact information provided in the entry form within three (3) days after three (3) attempts have been made, the winner will be disqualified and prize may not be awarded in Wizards’ sole discretion.

All decisions made by Wizards on all matters relating to this Contest are binding. By entering the Contest, entrants agree to abide by the judges’ decisions and waive any right to appeal.

**5. Prizes and Approximate Retail Value:**

The individual winner (or each member of the winning team) will receive: (a) one copy of *A Practical Guide to Dragons* and one copy of the *Green Dragon Codex*, and (b) have their lyrics featured on an mp3 posted at [www.mirrorstonebooks.com](http://www.mirrorstonebooks.com) along with their first name, their team name if applicable, and the name of their participating library. The winning entry will also be sent out for promotional purposes. Approximate retail value: Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00 USD) or up to one hundred dollars (\$100.00 USD) for winning team.

The winner's corresponding participating library will win: (a) two copies of the following: *A Practical Guide to Dragons*, *Red Dragon Codex*, *Bronze Dragon Codex*, *Black Dragon Codex*, *Brass Dragon Codex*, and *Green Dragon Codex*, (b) two *Practical Guide* calendars, and (c) an assortment of bookmarks. Approximate retail value: Two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00 USD).

Prizes are not transferable. Wizards, in its sole discretion, may substitute a prize for another product of equal value to the prize identified herein, or provide the cash equivalent.
